About Love in Music (LM)

 Founded in May 2007, Love in Music is a California non-profit 501(c)(3) charity organization based in Los Angeles. Stemming from the aftermath of the 4.29 L.A. Civil Uprising, our mission is to help build a more loving and harmonious community through music education by a team of musically trained volunteers.

Mission

 Empower the younger generation in our community by fostering collaboration among culturally diverse communities in Los Angeles, Orange County, and the South Bay areas through music.

PROGRAM LOGISTICS & GUIDELINES

1. Student Enrollment

- New students must submit signed forms: "Student Application," "Parent Consent for Waiver of Liability," "Parent Consent to be Filmed/Photographed," and, if applicable, an Instrument Rental Agreement Form.
- Upon approval, attend scheduled classes with a student binder and name tag for free weekly lessons from Love in Music's team of musically trained teachers.

2. LM Class Venue(s) & Location(s):

- Classes in Los Angeles, South Bay, and Santa Ana, each held on Saturdays during school year.
- Follow venue-specific check-in procedures; collect name tags and move to assigned teachers or classrooms.

3. Use of the Classroom/Facility:

- Maintain cleanliness and care for classroom, equipment and furniture in compliance with partnering organization's policy.

4. Attendance/Absence Notification:

- Notify planned/unplanned absences by Thursday of each week in advance through a designated platform or representatives (LM Volunteers to report on Discord).
- More than two unexcused absences may result in a loss of participating privileges.

5. Instrument Management:

- Love in Music provides instruments to participating students; parents are responsible for safe maintenance.
- Report damages promptly; repair costs due to mishandling by the students are the responsibility of their parents.

6. Understanding:

- Address program-related questions or concerns to Support Coordinators of each branch during enrollment. Parents of students are responsible for attending PTA meetings as needed by Love in Music and/or partnering organization.

7. Participation in Events/Activities:

- Attend all events and activities in addition to weekly lessons, including two biannual musical events including Mini Winter Concert at the end of fall semester and Annual Concert at the

end of a school year.

8. Communication with Love in Music and among Parents:

- Parents must sign up for communication apps as required by Love in Music (apply to L.A./South Bay); Support Coordinators of each branch will assist in the signing process.

9. Contact Point(s):

- Support Coordinators at each branch handle attendance, program organization and administrative matters in close coordination with Love in Music and its partnering organization.

10. Class Schedule:

- Plan to attend class on time: 10:00 am (Santa Ana) and 2:00 pm (L.A. & South Bay).
- Class schedule is subject to change as deemed necessary by Love in Music and its partnering organization per branch.
